Getting your pet to Dignity

Prior to bringing your pet to Dignity, you need to book an appointment with us. Alternatively, your pet is collected by us from your vet/home.



Pre-cremation wishes

At your request, we will take any paw prints, fur clippings & keepsakes. After these are checked your pet will be approved for cremation.



Ashes are homed

We will home the ashes of your pet in your chosen casket/urn.













Step 6



Courtesy Call

We will call you to let you know your pet is safely with us. Wishes can be discussed and payment taken at this stage or on an alternative call (this may alter the overall timescale).



Individual cremation takes place

This will take place within 2 working days from the point of you giving us permission to proceed.



Collection or return of ashes

You can either collect your pet's ashes from Dignity or alternatively can carry out a vet return or home return via us or a courier.

Kim's journey with us

Our attended service, for Harry.

I lost Harry when he was 14 years old. We were not at our local vets so we had no idea where he was going and when that would be, which caused me a great deal of distress. I remembered Dignity from them dealing with my cat some 20 years ago and the sorrow was lightened when I called them for help. They immediately offered to get Harry when only hearing a small part of my sorrow and what was going on.

They treated him like a family member which he absolutely was, showing so much love and dignity.

I attended the service for Harry and I wanted him home for my birthday the following day. Again, this was handled with so much compassion and you could tell all of the staff genuinely cared and that our grief mattered. I was able to be with him before the cremation so I could say my final goodbyes in a much nicer environment. Dignity allowed me to put pictures with him and ensured he had his beloved blanket. He had a beautiful heart placed on his paw whilst I kept the keychain it came from. All these final touches made me feel like he mattered and that his time with me meant something. I was able to decide on his final journey and that was so important and certainly played a vital part in the healing process. I walked with Harry up the beautiful Remembrance Walkway and stayed with him whilst a prayer was said for him. I was then able to sit in the serene gardens and just be there with him so I could say I stayed right until the very end of his time on this earth.

I can't thank the staff enough for caring and allowing me to grieve in the most fitting way. Harry was a huge part of my life, my best friend, my shadow and having Dignity provide the service was the perfect way to show Harry just how much he meant to me. Life without Harry is still very hard but I know I gave him the best funeral.

The Atkins' Family Story

Our attended service, for Toffee.

We have used Dignity for all nine of our pets' final journeys over the last 13 years or so, most recently being for our much beloved. charismatic tortie. Toffee, Toffee was a huge presence in the house, always at the door when we came home, always up sharp in the morning screaming for breakfast and long snoozes on the sofa, dreaming of one day catching a pigeon. Toffee was just past 19 when we made the painful decision to let her go; her mind was sharp but her body had gone.



We opted for the Attended Service, as Toffee didn't like being alone and I didn't want her to be without us right until the last moment.

The lady who attended our appointment was lovely, she explained everything and talked through our wishes. When asked if I would like to carry Toffee, I declined and she was more than happy to carry Toffee. We went right to the kiln entrance, where the member of staff asked if it would be OK to say a little prayer, which he did and was a lovely touch.

We then walked around the woods, sat and enjoyed the gardens for a time. It's incredibly comforting to know such a well-established company are here for your pets and you, in those awfully sad and painful times. Kevin and the team have it all so well organised.

We chose the white coco metal urn, a keepsake heart with a fur clipping in and a small scatter tube for use in various rose plants at home and to use for jewellery (we chose an Alba Rose charm). We also had a keepsake glass heart with Toffee's ashes inside which was made by Bath Aqua Glass and I'm going to have a tattoo done with specially made ink with Toff's ashes in!


